Summary of Sermon for Konko Mission of Wailuku Autumn Grand Service

She decided to practice gratitude before every meal and even applied goshinmai (Konkokyo holy paper) to the affected area during the trip. To her amazement, her condition improved significantly. By the time she had her medical examination, the doctor confirmed her healing.

Konkokyo, founded by Konko Daijin, teaches us the importance of gratitude, faith, and our connection with Kami-Sama. Through gratitude, we can appreciate the blessings Kami-Sama provides through our meals and daily lives.
